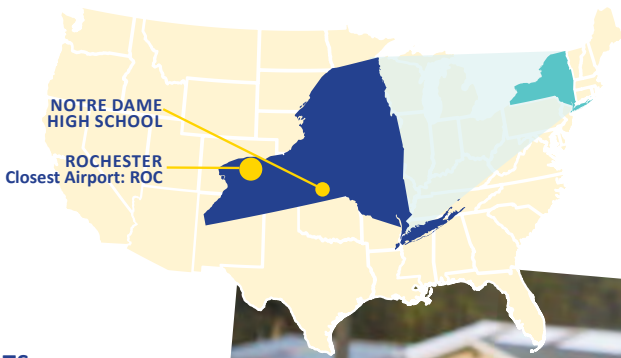




# Notre Dame High School
