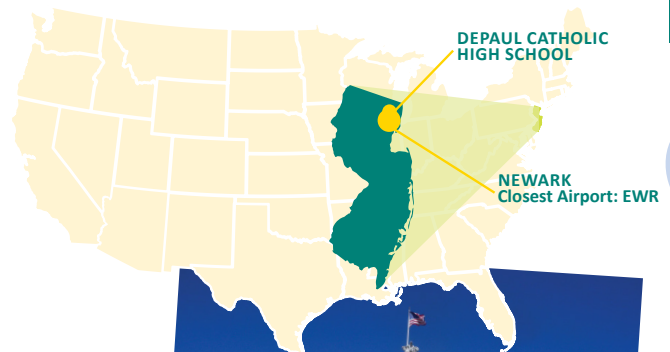

Students engage with various media and techniques used by artists in the creative process with classes like choir, mixed media, and theater.
