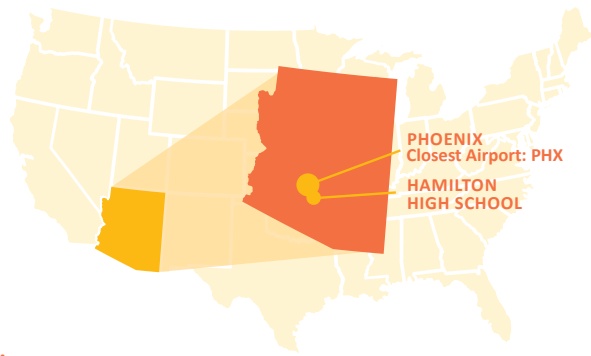

It also received the Siemens Award in 2006 as the number one Advanced Placement High School for Math and Science in Arizona.
