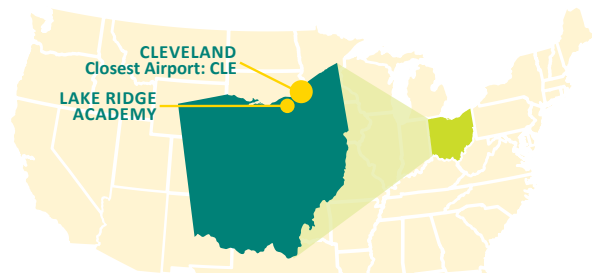




Lake Ridge Academy
