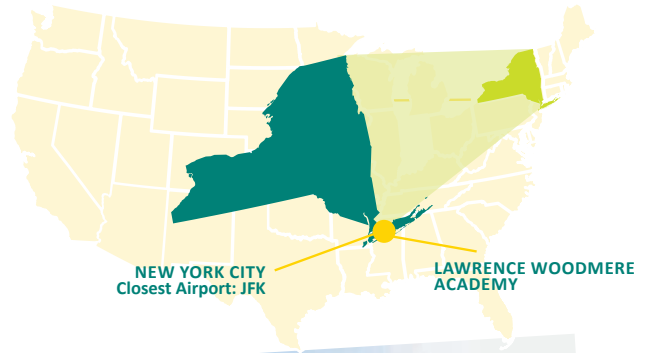




# Lawrence Woodmere Academy
