The St. Mary's Ryken High School Scholars Program features curriculum from the nationally recognized "Project Lead the Way". The program includes STEM tracks in engineering, computer science, and biomedical. Also part of the Scholars Program, students can seek accelerated concentrations in biomedical, global and international studies, humanities, and performing and visual arts.

#### **SPORTS AND ARTS**
